

The list of dangerous goods and substances prohibited for carriage by air is defined in Annex 4 of the Aviation Rules of Ukraine "Instructions on the organization and implementation of security control at airports of Ukraine", approved by the order of the State Aviation Administration of Ukraine, dated March 15, 2019 No 322.

1. For safety reasons, passengers and crew members are not allowed to carry the following goods in hand luggage and personal belongings to restricted areas and on board of aircraft:
 - pistols, firearms and other bullet launchers – devices which can be used to cause serious damage by firing a bullet, including:
 - all types of firearms, including pistols, revolvers, rifles and shotguns;
 - toy pistols, models and imitations of small arms, which can be considered real weapons;
 - components of small arms, except telescopic sights;
 - compressed air rifles and carbon dioxide canisters, including pistols, shotguns, and rifles;
 - signal rockets and starting pistols;
 - bows, crossbows and arrows;
 - harpoon rifles and spearguns;
 - slingshots;
 - shock devices, namely:
 - tools for shock (pistols, sticks, etc.);
 - devices of shock action on animals and devices of killing animals;
 - chemicals, gases and sprays that disable and paralyze (Mace gas, pepper spray, acid sprays, animal repellent sprays, and tear gas, etc.);
 - pointed or sharp-pointed objects, namely:
 - devices intended for chopping (axes, cutters, cleavers, etc.);
 - ice axes;
 - shaving blades;
 - knives for cutting cardboard;
 - knives with a blade length of more than 6 cm;
 - scissors with blades longer than 6 cm (if measured from the center of the hinge);
 - tools for martial arts with pointed ends or pointed edges;
 - swords and sabers;
 - work tools, namely:
 - mounting tools;
 - drills, including cordless portable electric drills;
 - tools with blades or rods longer than 6 cm, which can be used as a weapon (screwdrivers, chisels, etc.);
 - saws, including cordless portable electric saws;
 - blowtorches;
 - "guns" for fastening and driving nails;
 - blunt instruments, namely:
 - baseball bats and softball bats;
 - sticks and batons, namely different types of police sticks (hard, flexible and sticks with a lantern, etc.);
 - tools for martial arts;

- explosives and incendiary substances and devices, namely:
 - ammunition;
 - detonating capsules;
 - detonators and fuses;
 - copies or imitations of explosive devices;
 - mines, grenades and other explosive devices of military purpose;
 - pyrotechnics, including pyrotechnic articles for fireworks;
 - smoke bombs or cartridges;
 - dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives, etc
- 2. Passengers and crew members are not allowed to carry the following items in checked baggage:
 - explosives and incendiary substances and devices, namely:
 - ammunition;
 - detonating capsules;
 - detonators and fuses;
 - copies or imitations of explosive devices;
 - mines, grenades and other explosive devices of military purpose;
 - pyrotechnics, including pyrotechnic articles for fireworks;
 - smoke bombs or cartridges;
 - dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives, etc
 - e-Cigarettes & battery-powered smoking devices (only allowed in carry-on luggage)
- 3. Prohibited goods and substances in cargo shipments.

It is forbidden to carry mounted explosive and igniting devices in cargo and postal items, which are not transported in accordance with the existing safety rules.

Baggage transportation rules:

1. Liquids, Aerosols, and Gels (LAGs)

LAGs include substances such as toothpaste, shampoos, lotions, perfumes, beverages, soups, and gels.

Transport regulations:

- Only in tamper-evident security bags (STEBs)
- Each container must not exceed 100 ml/g
- Maximum 10 items per passenger, total volume not exceeding 1000 ml/g
- All items must be packed inside carry-on baggage

2. Medications allowed as per medical certificate.
